

# INTELLIGENT PROJECT KICK-OFF: DON'T WASTE YOUR TIME PLANNING

#### Introduction

Project kick-off is the single most important phase of a project, bar none.

There is a well-known saying "you cannot guarantee success when you launch a project, but you can certainly guarantee failure."

Too many organisations waste time trying to produce a detailed, credible plan during kick-off when it just isn't possible. This article describes a proven, intelligent approach that optimises the time spent at kick-off:

• Use outcome-driven planning to produce two plans :

1.a high-level plan that shows the Key Milestones which the stakeholders focus on

2.a detailed plan showing the activities needed to achieve the Milestones

 Don't plan what you don't know. Use rolling-wave planning to plan in detail for the next phase and in overview beyond that

### **Outcome-driven planning**

Outcome-driven planning is a simple but immensely powerful concept: before you rush off to do stuff, bring the key stakeholders together for a workshop and agree the outcomes you are trying to achieve.

- Once you've agreed the outcomes, build a high-level plan together then build detailed plans in teams
- · If you cannot agree the outcomes, abort

the initiative because it will not succeed

Here's an example high-level plan, showing overall Outcomes and interim Milestones and doesn't overwhelm the stakeholders with detail:

## Case Study : Staffordshire County Council

Staffordshire County Council is a democratically accountable organisation that serves a community of over 1 million people. The Council's vision is "a connected Staffordshire, where everyone has the opportunity to prosper, be healthy and happy".

The Council established the Transformation Support Unit (TSU) to provide a rigorous approach to shaping and delivering complex transformation projects. TSU decided to implement an efficient programme management tool to improve the co-ordination and visibility of these initiatives, with the following outcome:

•When all TSU initiatives are being governed in a consistent way, giving full





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visibility of progress, risks, costs, benefits and resource needs, and the Governance Boards systematically use information provided by TSU to inform their investment decisions
